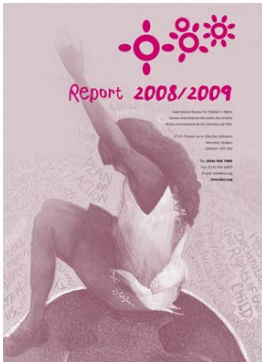




NEWS IN BRIEF FROM THE IBCR
