Congo - Tens of Thousands Forceably Displaced by Surge in Violence-Humanitarian Organizations Call for Urgent Assistance

3 May 2019 - Urgent action is needed to help tens of thousands of people forced to flee their homes following armed attacks in eastern Democratic Republic of Congo, 18 humanitarian organizations warned today. Those who remain are trapped between the border of Uganda and an area of DRC that is being terrorized by armed groups and close to the Ebola outbreak which has claimed over 950 lives.

Democratic republic of Congo - Girls' Lives Shattered by Attacks on Schools

20 May 2019 - Girls suffered sexual violence and other abuses when armed groups attacked hundreds of schools during the 2016-2017 Kasai conflict in the Democratic Republic of Congo, said the Global Coalition to Protect Education from Attack (GCPEA) in a report released today. The violence affected all children, but girls were particularly harmed, used as "magical" forces that would ward off bullets despite being unarmed, and raped and forcibly "married" to troops.
